ALUMNAE CHAPTER AWARDS

DEADLINE: MONDAY, MARCH 16, 2020, at 11:59 P.M.

OVERVIEW

Each Tri Delta alumnae chapter is encouraged to complete the [2020 Alumnae Chapter Awards application](#). Information submitted via the application will be supplemented by the detailed reports submitted via TriConnect throughout the 2019-2020 year.

The 2020 Alumnae Chapter Awards application allows applicants to add information, save and exit at any time. Content within the application can be edited until the application deadline.

Alumnae Chapter Awards to be presented at Convention 2020 include:

- Excellence in Member Experience
- Excellence in Collegiate Connection
- Excellence in Community Service and Engagement
- Excellence in Philanthropy
- Excellence in Innovation
- Eleanor Dorcas Pond Award for Overall Excellence

Alumnae chapters are not required to fill in each section of the application to be considered for awards. For example, if an alumnae chapter doesn't have a collegiate chapter that they interact with, they can skip that section. They won't be considered for the Excellence in Collegiate Connection Award but will be considered for the other awards.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for alumnae chapter awards, each alumnae chapter must have:

- Paid the operating and bonding fees for the year
- Paid member dues to the Fraternity
- Updated alumnae chapter bylaws on file with Tri Delta

VOLUNTEER SERVICE AWARDS

DEADLINE: MONDAY, MARCH 16, 2020, at 11:59 P.M.

OVERVIEW

The [2020 Volunteer Service Award](#) recognizes Tri Delta volunteers who have demonstrated outstanding service and commitment to Tri Delta and the members/chapters they serve.

The 2020 Volunteer Service Award application allows nominators to add information, save and exit at any time. Content within the application can be edited until the application deadline. Nominations can be submitted by collegiate and alumnae Tri Delta members. Nominators can submit as many nominations as they would like for the 2020 Volunteer Service Award.

Volunteer Service Awards will be presented at Convention 2020 and honor the following categories of volunteers:

- National/Regional Volunteer
- Collegiate Chapter Advisor or Team
- House Corporation Officer or Team
- Alumnae Chapter Officer or Team

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Volunteer Service Award, nominees must have met and exceeded all responsibilities in their respective volunteer efforts and served in one of the following volunteer positions during the 2019-2020 year:

National/Regional Volunteer: National Alumnae Volunteer Coordinator (NAVC), Alumnae Chapter Coordinator (ACCO), Alumnae Specialist (AS), Alumnae Celebration Specialist (ACS), Alumnae Philanthropy Specialist (APS), National Collegiate Volunteer Coordinator (NCVC), Collegiate Chapter Coordinator (CCCO), Collegiate District Officer (CDO) or Target Chapter Specialist (TCS), Financial Specialist (FS), Panhellenic Specialist (PS), Recruitment Specialist (RS), National Housing Volunteer Coordinator (NHVC), Housing Volunteer Coordinator (HVC), National Panhellenic Volunteer Coordinator (NPVC), National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) Tri Delta Representative, Tri Delta Foundation Committee Member, Award Committee Member, Standing Committee or Task Force Member, Other Special Appointment

Collegiate Chapter Advisor or Team: Collegiate Chapter Alumnae Advisor, Collegiate Chapter Other Advisor, Collegiate Chapter Advisory Team

House Corporation Officer or Team: House Corporation President, House Corporation Officer, House Corporation Officer Team

Alumnae Chapter Officer or Team: Alumnae Chapter President, Alumnae Chapter Officer, Alumnae Chapter Officer Team

ERNESTINE BLOCK GRIGSBY AWARD

ALUMNAE CHAPTER NOMINATION DEADLINE: SUNDAY, FEB. 16, 2020, at 11:59 P.M.

NOMINEE APPLICATION DEADLINE: WEDNESDAY, APRIL 1, 2020, at 11:59 P.M.

OVERVIEW

The 2020 Ernestine Block Grigsby Award recognizes one nominee from each Tri Delta alumnae chapter who, through her loyalty and dedication to Tri Delta, has given outstanding service to her local alumnae chapter.

Each alumnae chapter should [submit their chapter nomination](#) by the Feb. 16 deadline. Alumnae chapters can determine their nominee in whatever way works best for their members, including by vote, discussion or alumnae chapter officer decision.

Once award nominations from alumnae chapters are received, the nominees will receive further information, including the award timeline and application link, from Executive Office. Nominees will then have until the April 1 deadline to submit their application.

All award nominees will be recognized through Tri Delta media outlets and *The Trident*, and an overall winner will be determined for the 2020 Ernestine Block Grigsby Award and recognized at Convention 2020.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Ernestine Block Grigsby Award, each alumnae chapter nominee must:

- Be a current alumnae chapter member
- Be in good standing with Tri Delta
- Paid member and alumnae chapter dues
