



MOVE-IN GUIDANCE FOR RESIDENTS FALL 2020

We recognize you are excited to return to campus and the Tri Delta facility, and very much appreciate your understanding as we finalize details for fall move-in. We are thrilled to welcome you back to the Tri Delta facility, and in order to continue to prioritize the health and safety of our members, volunteers, and staff we have developed move-in guidance for residents. Your chapter reopening committee has been working closely to develop these plans. Please watch for more information regarding your specific chapter facility's move-in timing and instructions.

PREPARING FOR MOVE-IN

- Take seriously your responsibility to keep yourself, our Tri Delta employees, and your Tri Delta sisters healthy.
- Do not come to move-in if you are exhibiting any signs of COVID-19, have tested positive for and not yet recovered from COVID-19, or have been exposed to anyone showing symptoms of the disease.
- Procure move-in supplies to assist you with move-in. Consider purchasing sanitizing wipes, gloves and hand sanitizer to have on hand. Consider a dolly or cart to assist you with unloading.

SCHEDULING MOVE-IN

- Your reopening committee will provide details on how to schedule a move-in appointment. They will share the window for move-in, available appointment times and how to sign up. Appointment times will be limited to a small number of residents per appointment.
- Roommates should consider moving in during different appointment windows.
- Consider who you might bring to help with move-in. The number of additional helpers permitted at move-in may be limited. Do not bring a helper who is exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, has tested positive for the disease or has been exposed to anyone showing symptoms of COVID-19.

ON MOVE-IN DAY YOU SHOULD

- Take seriously your responsibility to keep yourself, our Tri Delta employees, and your Tri Delta sisters healthy.
- Follow house rules and CDC guidelines about social distancing, handwashing and hygiene.
- Tri Delta Housing recommends that members self-screen (take their own temperature) daily.
- Tri Delta Housing recommends that members wear masks in common areas of the house when six feet of social distancing is not possible.
- Bring no more than the permitted number of helpers to assist you with moving into your room.

- Utilize the guidance you have received on where to park when you arrive on-site and where to check in.
- Adhere to your designated move-in route and appointment window as communicated by the reopening committee.
- Be prepared to utilize your move-in appointment window efficiently. Focus your time on checking in, unloading your belongings, taking your belongings to your room, disposing of trash, and completing required forms.
